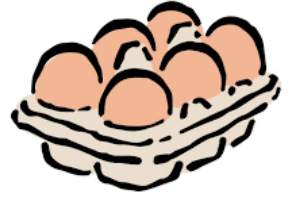


We can buy that!

Look at the examples and then answer the questions below.

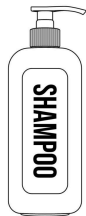
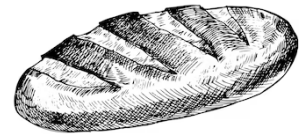


1. Sarah wants to buy eggs at the grocery store. Can she buy eggs there?
